Old Business:

The parade was successful, only two problems brought up; how to plan vendor area so that spots are already chosen on first come first served basis. This is how it will be done next year, per Haley. The other issue was throwing candy and it was said that the ones responsible were reprimanded and should not happen again.

December 15 - Membership voted to approve updated 2016 Bylaws. Membership approved current Secretary Paul Poore to step aside and become Member at Large, as Krista Kelley takes on full Secretary responsibilities.

New Business:

Bark in the Park Jasper –is Saturday, April 8, 2017, from 10 to 3. This will be in conjunction with Relay For Life of Pickens County Yard Sale and the first Community Yard Sale of 2017. The Jasper Farmers Market will also be held on this Saturday.

Gabe Northern of Zoo-Ology Zen Zone would like to be the food vendor using Haley's food cart. 10x10 booths are available for the event for \$20. They may be used for anything except food. Sponsorships start at \$20 and go up to \$500 with incentives at different levels. All money raised at Bark event goes to benefit Pickens County Animal Shelter.

Annual Easter Egg Hunt – Date is set for Saturday, April 15, 2017 at Lee Newton Park. This event will be tied into 2 other large events. The Spring Fling will be run by a local church as they will also help with hiding the eggs and will be held in the back section of the park and the 2017 Spring Jasper Arts Fair will be held in the park-n-ride on Stegall. The Jasper Farmers Market will also be held on this Saturday. First Christian Church of Jasper & Sky High Sports was last year's sponsor and have shown interest in repeating. Paul will be speaking to them more. We need businesses to donate filled eggs, minimum of 100 eggs per business, and we need a total of 3000-4000 eggs.
