The primary focus of the Parade of Lights, as part of the Night of Lights celebration, is to provide a safe, enjoyable, and quality parade on the streets of Downtown Jasper. There is a **\$10.00** fee to participate in the Parade of Lights and must accompany parade paperwork to receive a position in the lineup. This fee allows us to provide awards for parade winners.

PLEASE READ ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS Parade Rules:

- 1. All Vehicles and Floats must be in place by 4:30 PM; Walkers and Animals by 5:00 PM.
- 2. Parade application must be completed and returned by November 23, 2018
- 3. Driver of any motorized vehicle must have a valid driver's license and be 18 years or older. No skateboards or razor scooters.
- 4. For safety reasons, CANDY and OTHER ITEMS MAY NOT BE THROWN FROM VEHICLES OR FLOATS. Participants are asked to provide walkers to give out CANDY and OTHER ITEMS.
- 5. All applications are subject to approval by the JMA Board of Directors. You will be notified only if your application is rejected.
- 6. No Santa Suits allowed. Santa and Mrs. Claus will be the last entry in the parade to greet the children. **JMA reserves** the right to have the only SANTA.
- 7. Individuals and organizations are expected to perform courteously, in good taste, and with safety in mind at all times during the parade.
- 8. All parade entries must follow and display the parade theme to be included in judging.
- 9. Entries MUST have the name of entry clearly marked on the Driver's side door to be included in judging.
- 10. If the unit has animals in it, you MUST provide waste cleanup.
- 11. Anyone wishing to have **HORSES/PONIES** in the parade must have **Negative Coggins Documentation** returned with paperwork. **DOGS or OTHER SMALL ANIMALS** must have a current **Rabies Vaccination**.
- 12. By signing your application, you are acknowledging that you have read and agree to these rules and disclaimer below.

Additional Note: No applications will be accepted after November 23, 2018. Only valid (on time and paid) entries will be listed in the KnowPickens.com youtube video *Night of Lights 2018 Program*.

Disclaimer: Applicant agrees to participate in the Parade of Lights at Applicant's own risk and covenants not to sue the Jasper Merchants Association (JMA) Board of Directors or Members for any injury or damage suffered by Applicant as a result of said participation. Applicant agrees that the JMA shall be free from all claims, by reason of any injury to any person, from any cause whatsoever arising from any occurrence in or near the Parade. Applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless the JMA against any and all such claims.

Any deviations to these rules have to be approved by the JMA Board of Directors.





Scoring Guidelines:

- Parade Theme: 15 possible points and 30% of your total score. Does your float portray the festival theme?
- Originality/Creativity: 10 possible points and 20% of your total score. Is your float unique from all the other floats? How does your float illustrate the festival theme and depict your group's personality?
- Personalization: 10 possible points and 20% of your total score. While conforming to the theme, does your business, club, or organization's message still come through? Can I tell who you are and what you are about through your float?
- Spirit of Christmas: 15 possible points and 20% of your total score. After all, this is a Christmas Parade. Hint

 a fireside book reading, children building a snowman, or a living nativity will earn you more points than simply wearing Santa hats. (Please no Santa Clause on your floats. See parade rules.)
- City of Jasper/Pickens County Element: 5 possible points for 10% of your total score. This is our community and our parade. What does this city mean to you? Show us in your float.

Total possible Points: 50

Tuesday, November 27th, 2018 at 6:00pm located in the Conference Room at Jasper City Hall, 200 Burnt Mountain Road. Please make plans to attend this meeting or have a representative do so on your behalf to get your line-up position and time. There will be NO line-up changes made after this meeting or on the day of the parade. To be eligible for Best in Show and Theme Trophies you must have a decorated vehicle in the Parade.
