We need to set Vendor Price, rules, map, & booth size so applications can be finished. Price was set at \$25 for vendors. The rest was tables until Nov meeting.



It was suggested that we encourage Music on floats, make sure that is on the application so they can be spaced according to music. Floats MUST be decorated according to theme. Floats must be marked with name on the drivers' side door where judges can easily recognize it. Judges must have unobstructed view from their seating on the stage. Geoff Chalk offered to make a judging scoresheet.

Kirk has confirmed that Hans Rueffert from the Woodbridge Inn will be the Grand Marshall. Lawton Baggs will read the Christmas Story. Our honorary Grand Marshall will be Edward Stephens, He is a WWII vet and has done a lot in the community over his lifetime.

Keely and Geoff offered to work with us on good quality table skirts for the judges table, and banners/signage for the event in exchange for their annual membership.

Working on ads in the Pickens Progress in Sept to encourage more floats for the parade. Ava Rogers and WYYZ will handle the announcing/stage. WYYZ sells ad space on the stage to cover their fee for the parade. Ava asks that on any advertising for the parade, we include "WYYZ MUSIC STAGE". They sell 4 banner spots at \$250 each. She would like JMA to assist in selling the ads if possible.

Sponsorship forms will be available for this event as soon. Vendor booths will be \$25. CF Printing & Promotions will have a deal for JMA sponsors packages.
